Rent Rebates:

You may qualify for a rent rebate! If you are:

- Age 65 or older as of December 31st, 2020
- Under age 65 with a spouse age 65 or older who resides in the same household with you as of December 31st, 2020
- A widow or widower, age 50 to 64 as of December 31, 2020
- Permanently disabled and age 18 to 64 during 2020

Tenants can call State Representative Stephanie Borowicz's Office at **(570) 748-5480** to see if they qualify, or if they need help completing their rebates.

Tenants can also call Ruth at the CCHA at **(570) 748-2954 EXT #1** if they need a rent certificate verifying the rent they paid in 2020.

- CCHA Reminders from Maintenance -

- ♦ Lock-Out Service ends at 11 PM. Maintenance will not respond after this time.
- ♦ Tenants should have all outdoor summer items put away by the end of the first week in October. Compliance notices will be sent after October 8, 2021.
- ♦ Maintenance will begin removing air conditioners on October 11, 2021. The heat will be turned on once the weather becomes cold enough. No Smoking in the buildings or on CCHA property.

DO NOT flush any of the following items down the commodes:

- ♦ Bars of soap
- ♦ Clothing or material of any kind
- ♦ Adult undergarments or protective wear
- ♦ Disposable diapers
- ♦ Grease from cooking

- ♦ Tampons/sanitary napkins
- ♦ Wipes
- ♦ Food
- ♦ Toys
- ♦ Paper towels
